ASSEMBLY DISTRICTS 79, 80, & 81

Between Oct., 2015 and Nov., 2019, We the Irrelevant queried legislators in this district via open record requests. The requests asked for records of all contacts from citizens on GOP-promulgated legislation under consideration. Those contacts included emails, letters, and phone calls. Records were tallied according to how many contacts opposed the proposed legislation and how many supported it. The one exception to this arrangement is Gov. Evers' special session called to debate two gun-control bills in Nov., 2019. Consistency required that contacts in support of the bills be counted with the opposition to all of the other bills.

Below is a summary of all of the SD 27 contacts.
