

We the Irrelevant queried legislators via open records requests. They were asked to provide records of all citizen contacts received within a specific time frame, including letters, emails, and phone calls. Those contacts were tallied and published at www.we-the-irrelevant.org. This spreadsheet lists the issues/bills queried, how many contacts were opposed, how many were in favor, and how the legislator voted. Challengers on the Nov. 3, 2020 ballot and their contact information may be found on the bottom of page 2.
