

This display lays out Wisconsin's monthly relative position among 10 other states since the April 7 GOP-mandated, vote-in-person primary. As you'll note, I've included other unique-to-WI milestones as well. My original 6-state cohort is marked by the deeply-shaded cells with white numbers. The other 5 states, marked with pastels and black numbers, passed through the cohort over time. I selected the original cohort because, like Wisconsin, they had COVID-19 case counts between 2000 and 2,999 on April 7. I didn't know about ranking based on cases per 100k population. If I had, I might have made different choices. I know now that it is really the only way to make legitimate comparisons among states, so I'm using it here. Beneath each milestone, the states are arranged by the per 100K calculation in ascending order. Their respective relative positions change accordingly as you scan right. WI has added 81,705 new cases since Dec. 31, 2020. Its relative position has improved from 9th to 3rd.
